Turn AI into Your Personal Executive Briefing Assistant

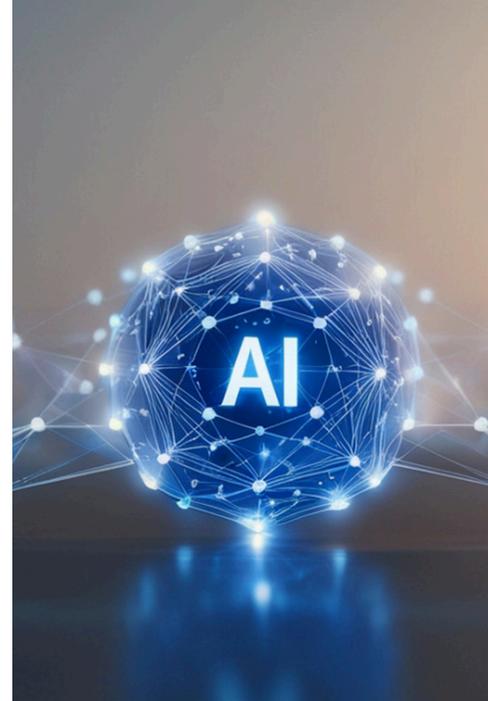
AI Tools for Leaders: The Top-Rated Assistants for Stacking Capabilities

There is no single AI tool that does everything perfectly. The most productive professionals today use a small stack of AI tools, each optimized for a different task. The smartest AI users don't rely on just one system, they use each tool for what it does best.

Example workflow used by many executives:

- **Research**
 - Use Perplexity to gather current data and sources.
- **Analysis**
 - Upload articles or reports into Claude to summarize insights.
- **Strategy & Messaging**
 - Use ChatGPT to develop strategy, presentations, or communications.
- **Execution**
 - Use Copilot to create documents, slides, and meeting notes.

This layered approach turns AI into a comprehensive digital research and strategy team.



Pro Tip: “Prompt Chaining”

Advanced users often use prompt chaining, where the output from one AI tool becomes the input for another.

Example:

- Ask Perplexity for recent industry data.
- Paste the findings into ChatGPT and ask for strategic implications.
- Use Copilot to build the presentation.

This can reduce hours of research into minutes.

AI is not about replacing expertise. It’s about augmenting human judgment with faster access to insight. Leaders who learn to combine AI tools effectively will have a significant advantage in decision-making and productivity.
